Change Email Address

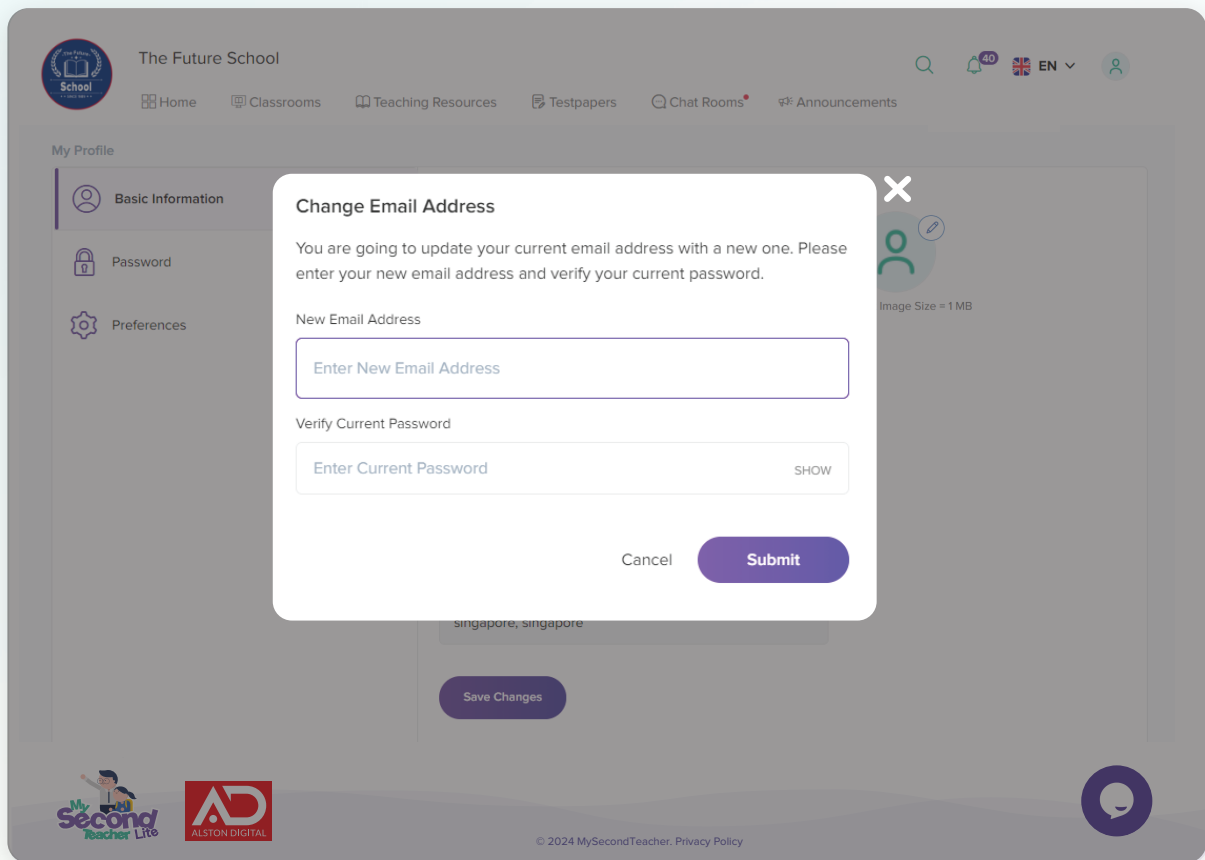
Teachers can now change their email address using the following steps:
